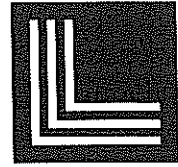

Dear Sir/Madam

RE: ANTHONY (TONY) FAWAZ

I acted for Tony in Supreme Court Proceedings BS6584 of 2008.

These proceedings were primarily relating to an action brought by Vision Gateway Inc against Moretonsoft Pty Ltd.

In essence Vision Gateway Inc claimed that Moretonsoft Pty Ltd and its directors and employees had stolen certain software.

On 3 April 2009 Justice Dutney ordered that Vision Gateways Inc's claim be dismissed and that Vision Gateway Inc pay each of the Defendant's (which included Moretonsoft Pty Ltd and Tony), costs.

My assessment of the case led me to firmly believe that there was no merit whatsoever in Vision Gateway Inc's claims.

Contemporaneously with these proceedings a number of former directors based throughout the world maintained a defamatory website entitled "The Moretonsoft Crew".

Moretonsoft Pty Ltd engaged me to deal with the various hosts of that website. I was successful in having it shut down a number of times however the tech savvy individuals who maintained it would simply find another host and reactivate the site.

Ultimately my instructions were to ignore the site largely because of the fact that;-

1. The persons maintaining it seemed intent on doing so and the costs of preventing them in foreign jurisdictions was prohibitive; and
2. Most, if not all, of the material published on the site was exceedingly defamatory, not true and frankly gibberish.

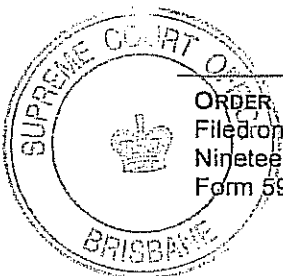



1. the action be dismissed,
2. the plaintiffs shall pay the defendants costs of and incidental to the action, to be assessed on the standard basis.
3. the plaintiffs shall pay the costs and outlays of the independent solicitor, James Conomos and his employees and servants, without prejudice to the right of the applicants to recover such costs and outlays from the respondents, at the rate and on the basis set out in the schedule to paragraph 22 of the affidavit of Mr Conomos, filed by leave on 8 July 2008.
4. subject to any subsequent order of this Court, the independent solicitor is to retain the property presently in the independent solicitor's possession.
